





TRUSTEES AND CHAPEL RESTORATION

We have done the following:

- 1. Removed the ductwork above the suspended ceiling
- 2. Removed the old lighting
- 3. Installed new HVAC outlets and returns
- 4. Installed new lighting
- 5. Repaired the ceiling and painted it





TRUSTEES: We are upgrading the Education Building with the same access system that is on the Worship Center.

OUTREACH COMMITTEE

Our First Meeting was on Monday, February 5th at 6:00pm. Those in attendance were Reverend Michele Lott, Mike Bowles & Dor, Richard Woodings-Ybarra. Our opening prayer was as follows:

"God, thank you for giving us constant access to your Holy Spirit. Even when we don't know what or how to pray for it, your Holy Spirit prays on our behalf. Thank you for being the God who is always present. Today, draw us nearer to you, align us to be the center of our lives. In your Holy Name, Amen"

We discussed the branding of the blood drive. We motioned for the name to be: Cross Tracks Blood Drive for Life with The American Red Cross. The representative from the American Red Cross confirmed all areas of the website with respect to registration online. All marketing materials will be branded as such in time for the current blood drive and all future blood drives.

Our first Cross Tracks Blood Drive for Life is scheduled for April 24th from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. We are committed to **40 donors** which will make a total of <u>26 units</u>. For reference: Every 1 donor, we impact 3 lives.

Our needs for the Blood Drive are as follows:

- Northern quarter of the worship centers space approximately 1,200 square feet. - Scheduled and confirmed
- 6 rectangular folding tables Scheduled and confirmed ✓
- 20 covered cloth chairs Need covers, padded chairs confirmed ✓
- Need to have available or donated:
 - o Nutritional snacks & drinks for any accompanying children.
 - o Possibly 1 person for those who ask about our worship services (Informative Materials available).
 - o Volunteers of course. We need approximately 20 on rotation. 2 people for setup between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. 2 people for teardown & cleanup between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. And 16 people (MINIMUM) for DEDICATED rotation in assisting those registered donors.

Last and equally as important, Cross Tracks has committed to the sponsorship of the Girls Softball Team. Our \$400 commitment comes with the need for dedication. Dedication by us as faithful followers of Christ to show our support by attending their softball games. Check your Sunday Bulletin for dates, times and locations.
